Categories on Incident Readonly

Categories on the Incident interface, when loaded, are readonly. There is now an edit button that allows the Categories to be edited This is controlled by a new config



Event Statuses Can be Set on Mobile Only

Event statuses that relate to the engineer going offsite should not be settable in the desktop app as it causes problems for the engineer on mobile. These can now be excluded from desktop.

Financials



Document Type Prefixes

You are now able to defined Document Type prefixes that are then displayed on Document Listing and Supplier Statements.

Statement Changes

If Document Prefix is set for documents, then when the statement is printed, the document will display the defined prefix

Purchase Order lines unlocked

Purchase Order line items can be set to not be locked, even when linked to posted documents.

Debtor Journal Allocations

On the Journal Document Listing interface, there is now a new Column to indicate what is allocated to Debtor Journal Entries

Receiving of goods to warehouse Only

Receiving of goods via the Count by Scanning interface, now allows users to only select a Warehouse if the config is true.

DIY Reports

Hyperlinks in embedded SSRS Reports Open Inline

SSRS reports displayed inline in Pulse can now be directed to open hyperlinks in their own frame, rather than opening a new window.

Top Search Remembers the Document

The top search remembers which document you last searched for. So, if you open the invoice results then the next time you search you will be taken there directly.
